

INDOOR ARCHERY WA 2023/24 RANKING PRIZE POOL

1. Overall Tournament Champion

\$600

The archer who completes the Indoor Archery WA tournament season with the highest achieved score.

2. Division Tournament Champions

1st Place \$300

2nd Place \$100

The archers who complete the Indoor Archery WA tournament season with the highest achieved scores on each of the three (3) Indoor Archery WA series target faces.

3. Female Tournament Champion

\$100 Indoor Archery WA Gift Card

The female archer who completes the Indoor Archery WA tournament season with the highest achieved score.

4. Junior Tournament Champion

\$100 Indoor Archery WA Gift Card

The junior archer who completes the Indoor Archery WA tournament season with the highest achieved score.

The qualifying score must be achieved while the archer is under the age of 18 years old.

5. Team Tournament Champions

1st Place \$900

2nd Place \$450



3rd Place \$150

Archers who have achieved a qualifying score may enter into teams. Teams are to be made up of three archers.

Archers wishing to nominate as a team must notify Indoor Archery WA during a sanctioned tournament. Once an archer has nominated as part of a team that team is final for the tournament season.

Archers can only be members of one team. However, archers with multiple qualifying scores may use any single qualified score for the team total.

Where a team finishes 1st, 2nd or 3rd with a qualifying score from each series of target a

\$300 BONUS Indoor Archery WA Gift Card will be awarded.

Where a team finishes 1st, 2nd or 3rd with a junior archer a \$300 BONUS

Indoor Archery WA Gift Card will be awarded. Junior qualifying scores must be achieved when the archer is up to and including 17 years old. Juniors who turn 18 during the tournament season will be eligible with their team for this bonus utilising any improved score after turning 18 years old.

6. Rules and Qualifying Criteria

- (a) Only scores achieved during sanctioned Indoor Archery WA tournaments will be used.
- (b) The final Indoor Archery WA tournament will be held on Thursday the 17th of April 2025.
- (c) The Indoor Archery WA ranking list will be used to show the standings of archers.
- (d) Where archers competing for the same prize have a tied score the archer who first achieves the score will assume the superior position.
- (e) Where archers competing for the same prize have a tied score and the score is achieved on the same date an 'X' countback will be used. The archer with the highest 'X' count will assume the superior position.



- (f) Where archers competing for the same prize have a tied score on the same date and the same 'X' count. The archers will participate in a golden arrow shoot off at the direction of the tournament director.
- (g) Archers can win more than one prize.
- (h) Prizes will be presented on completion of the last qualifying tournament.
- (i) Where an archer is not present to receive a prize on completion of the last qualifying tournament. 25% of the prize money awarded will be withheld.
- (j) Prizes must be collected from Indoor Archery WA by attending the venue during published staffed hours within fourteen (14) days of being awarded. Prizes not collected after fourteen (14) days will be forfeited.
- (k) Archers can have qualifying scores on the ranking list on multiple series of targets recognised.
